Key Scripture: Exodus 1

Life Group Discussion Questions

1. What kind of leader do you respond to the most?
2. Read Exodus 1. What kind of leadership does the Pharaoh exhibit? Have you ever experienced this kind of leadership in your life – what was it like?
3. What are your thoughts on the actions of Shiphrah and Puah in this story? Are they lousy followers or good leaders?
4. What next steps will you take in order to apply this week's teaching

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Week 2: God's Shaping of a Leader

January 15th – 21st

Key Scripture: Exodus 2

Life Group Discussion Questions

1. Who was the most influential person in your spiritual development? Why?
2. Read Exodus 2:1-10. Moses would have grown up knowing the story of how his life was saved as a baby. How do you think this would have shaped his understanding of God and his purpose?
3. Read Exodus 2:11-25. How do you imagine God used these experiences in Moses' life to shape him as a leader?
4. Do you recognize a defining moment in your life that shaped you to be the person you are?

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Week 3: The Power of Vision

January 22nd – 28th

Key Scripture: Exodus 3:1-10

Life Group Discussion Questions

1. Share about a time when you made a decision too quickly based on your immediate circumstance and neglecting to look at the future.
2. Read Exodus 3:1-6. How do you visualize Moses' "strange" encounter with God?
3. Read Exodus 3:7-10. How do you visualize where God wanted Moses to lead the people of Israel? In your mind what does the place look like? Use your imagination!
4. Has God given you a vision for your life, a preferable future?

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Week 4: God's Calling of a Leader

January 29th – February 5th

Key Scripture: Exodus 3:11 – 4:17

Life Group Discussion Questions

1. What's one of the worst excuses you have ever used to get out of doing something?
2. Read Exodus 3:11-4:17. Identify all the excuses Moses uses with God for not wanting to take on his God-given role. Have you ever used any of these excuses with God?
3. If God called you to lead, on a scale from 0-10, how willing would you be to lead?
4. Is there such a thing as a reluctant leader?
