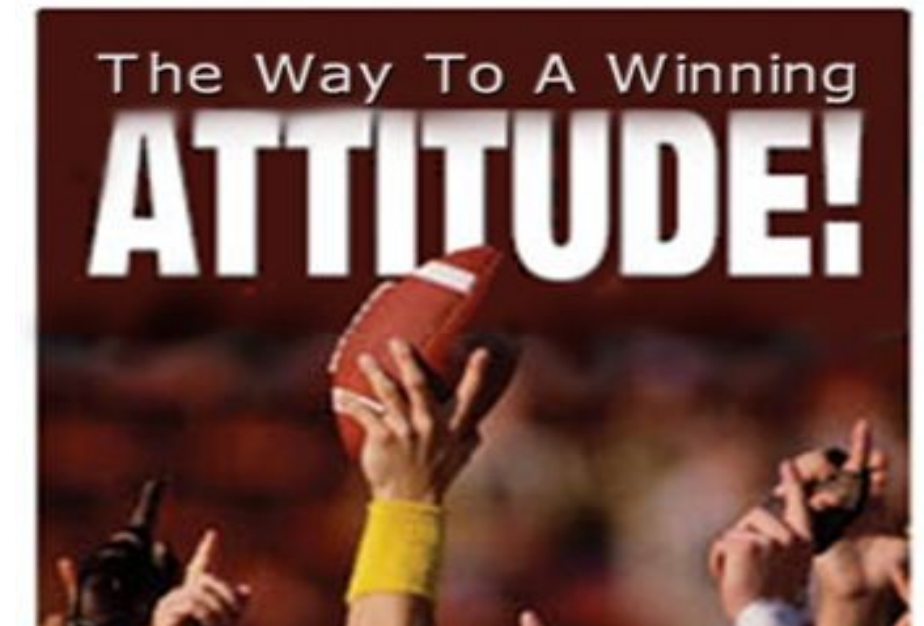

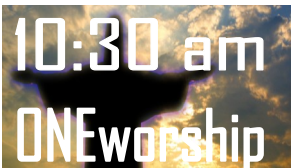

- ◆ **ADULT LIFE GROUPS:** Please visit the Connection Central Booth in the Hospitality room for available groups.



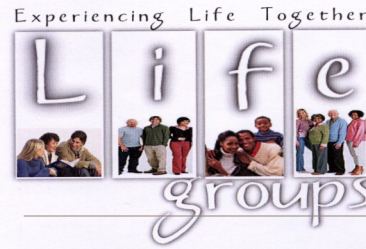
ONE Worship at 10:30am meets in the worship center and is a contemporary, multi-media experience with a practical, life-changing teaching. Middle School students attends this service.
