Plus other projects and some you may know of. Please let John know, either by phone or email a.s.a.p. as he needs to make work lists for individuals or teams.

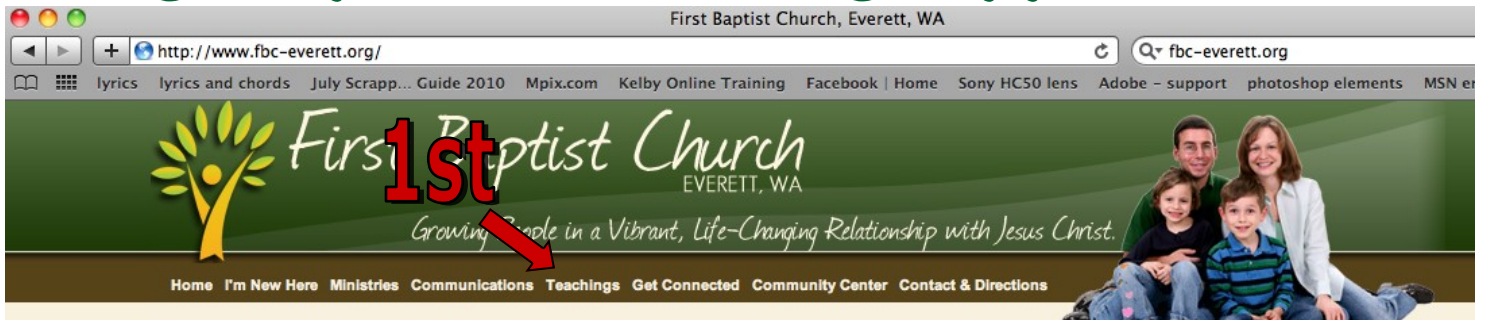
S.A.M. Happenings
