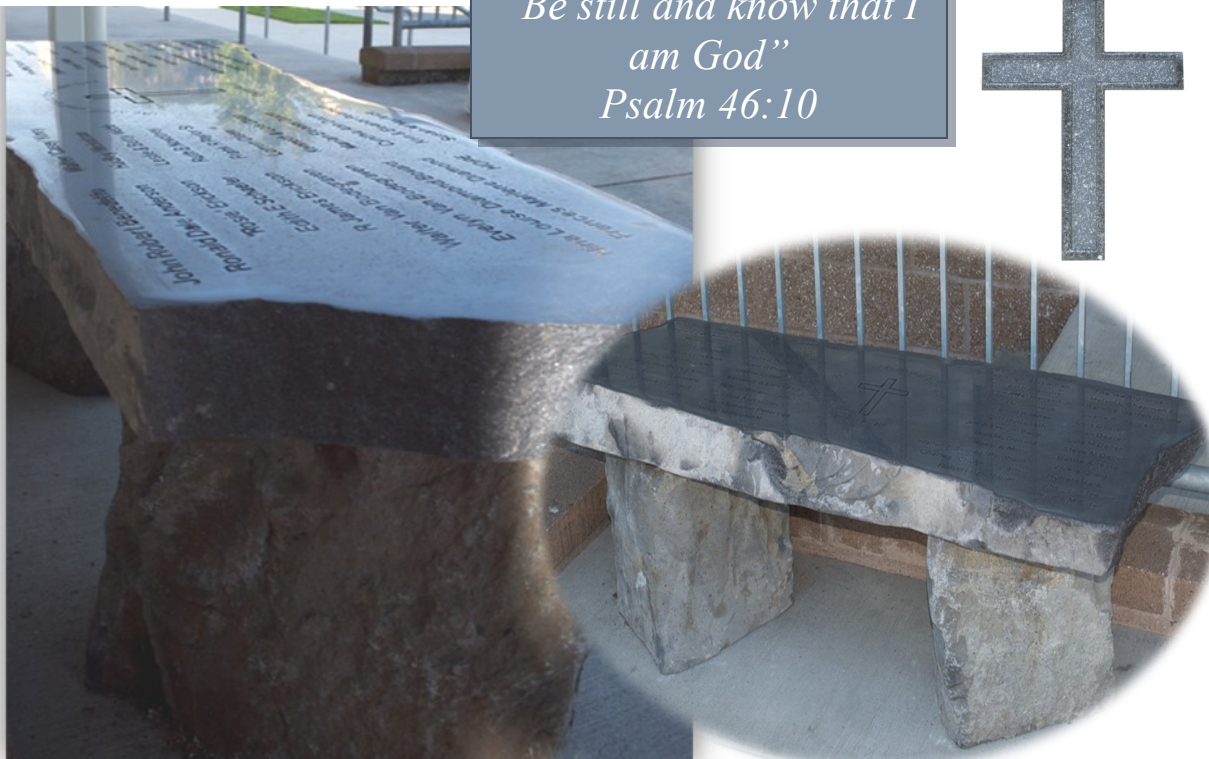


CareNNECTION Memorial Bench

- Help inventory the Music Library music and instruments

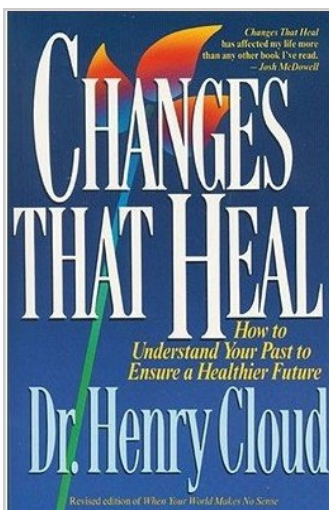

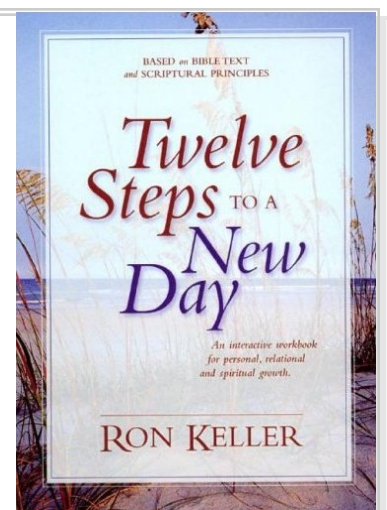
