## A Study of PSALM 119 Discovering and Using God's Treasures

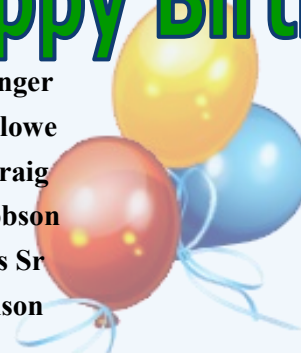
Summer Bible study Wednesdays, at 12:00 pm in the Pacific Room.
