

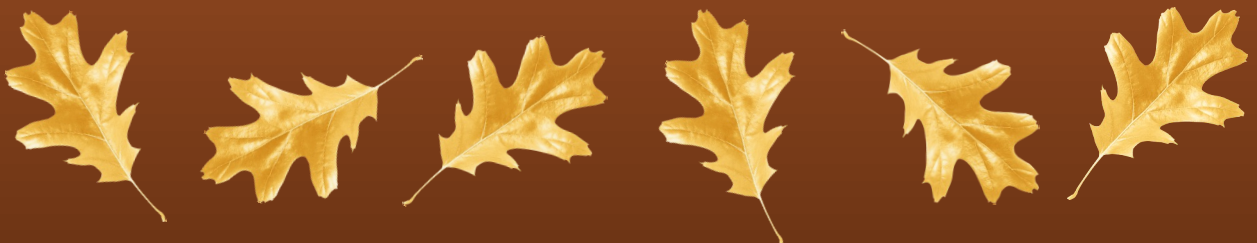

UPDATE FROM LOU & PAT

Hello to all of you again!

The last few days have been very busy. Friday, the engineering team finished their drawings and put together a very professional presentation that showed pictures of the land, the site plan, drawings of the kitchen/dining facility and a cabin, and a drawing of the face of both buildings. We had a little party Friday night with some of the ministry workers from different villages, and the engineers gave their presentation. They even took time to build a 3-dimensional model (out of cardboard) and presented that to Gama and Ligia. Gama and Ligia (and all of us) are very pleased with the plans, the drawings, and the architectural design of the buildings, and we are amazed at the amount of work this team of engineers has accomplished in under 2 weeks. God has truly blessed us with them. The team director, who has lead 38 teams all around the world in work like this, says it was truly a miracle how God brought us all together and that confirms to him that God wants Camp John 3:16 built.

Today we all went to church in another pueblo, Conkal, and had a good time worshipping with friends there. We saw Jorge (from July's camp) and he said "hello" to all his camp friends. There are just a few days left for the engineers to complete their work (they leave Wednesday), although we can get answers and help from them after they go home. It continues to be unusually hot here for October - even the locals are saying it's too hot. We're managing (and I'm not complaining!!! Thanks for your prayers!) and are blessed to go home each night to air conditioning.

The surveyor is hoping to get a few locations marked (markers on the road and at least one building) tomorrow - that's something they were not planning to do, but he's excited to do as much for us as he can. They've all become really attached to the project and to Gama, Ligia, Lou and me and will keep us and the project in their prayers (and hope to see it after it's built). Please continue to pray for us and the engineers - we have just 1 week until we come home. Also, please continue to pray for Gama and Ligia as they continue their ministry here. God bless you all for your prayers and thoughts for all of us! ~Pat and Lou
